

Drama = a play is a type of drama

Script = the special form of a play

Setting = the time and place of a story

Scene = a part of the action in a play in a specific setting of the story.

descriptions = give more detail about the setting or how the characters are feeling.

Cast of characters = the parts people act out in a play.

stage directions = tell actors what to do

dialogue = the lines each character speaks

narrator = a person who provides information to the audience.

theme = the lesson or message of the play

drama (noun) = a story presented with actors in front of an audience.

syn: play, show, performance

prose (noun) = A series of sentences that do not have the rhythmic structure like poetry.

syn: story, essay, composition
